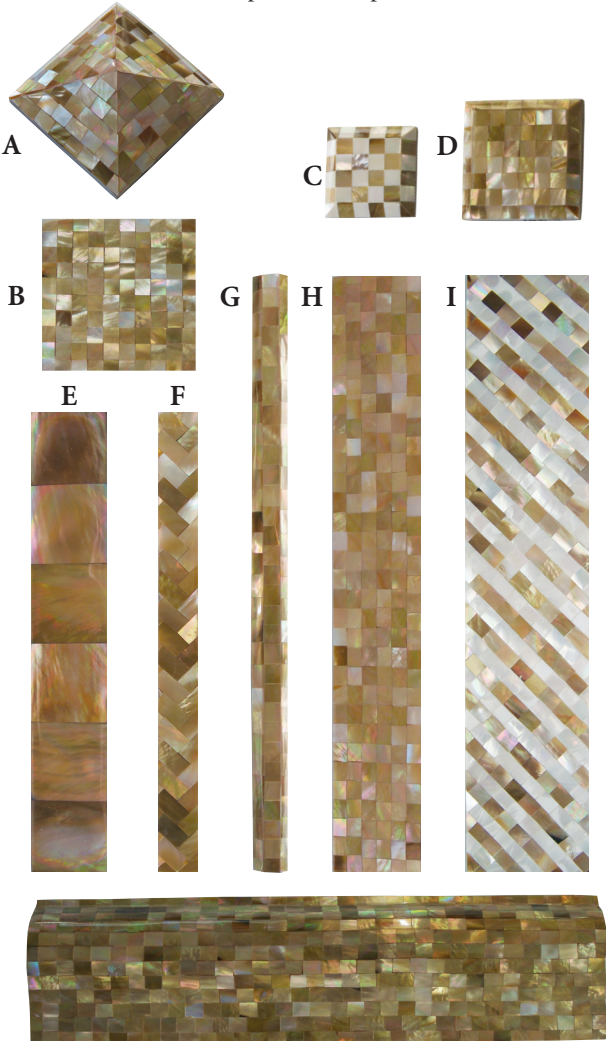


## A Sampling of Sizes & Shapes

- A. 2" x 2" Pyramid
- B. 2" x 2" Flat (*actual: 50 mm x 50 mm*)
- C. 1 $\frac{1}{16}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{16}$ " Beveled (*actual: 30 mm x 30 mm*)
- D. 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " Beveled (*actual: 41 mm x 41 mm*)
- E. 1" x 6" Flat Liner
- F. 1/2" x 6" Flat Pencil
- G. 1/2" x 8" Rounded Pencil (*actual: 1/2" x 200 mm*)
- H. 1 $\frac{1}{16}$ " x 8" Flat Liner (*actual: 30 mm x 200 mm*)
- I. 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 8" Flat Liner (*actual: 41 mm x 200 mm*)
- J. 2" x 8" Molding

## The Satin Series

The *Satin Series* is a unique collection of tiles made from an oyster shell. The shell is very transparent. By tinting the epoxy used to affix the shell to the base material, we create other colors.



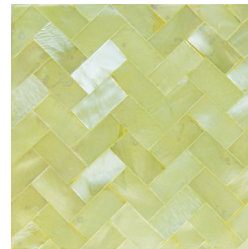

**L**YRIC TILE's seashell mosaics are a collection of decorative liners and inserts individually handcrafted in the Philippines. Environmentally friendly, the tiles are created from discarded shells originally harvested as a food source. With the exception of Coconut, which is a tree's fruit, the shells are from Indo-Pacific waters. None of the shells are among endangered species.

Each shell is cut, applied to a ceramic base, and polished – not coated – to reveal a shiny, jewel-like finish which resembles marble in look and durability. The tiles are suited for installation in almost any indoor setting appropriate for marble, except underwater.

The tiles, with the exception of Blue Opal and Coconut, can be used in areas exposed to high humidity or wetness (non-steam shower enclosures or bath tub surrounds), provided they and the adjacent grout joints are sealed before and after grouting, and periodically maintained with sealer. The tiles should not be cleaned with any product containing abrasives or acids.

### Custom Items

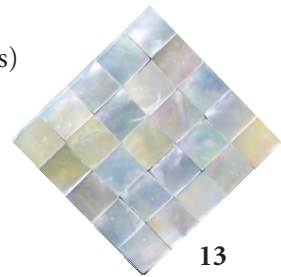
In addition to its standard and custom-designed tiles, Lyric produces custom-made items. Using wood, granite, plastic or glass as the base material, we can finish a wide variety of shapes and sizes in shell. Among these custom-made items are electric switch covers, cabinet knobs, table and chest tops, mirror and picture frames, architectural columns, tissue boxes, door jambs, and retail display cases.

These shell materials are completely natural and, as with any natural product, there will be variations in color, shade and marking.

### Details

Tiles are available in all the shells, in most patterns and shapes, in any size up to 12" x 12" (300 mm x 300 mm). They can also have one or more beveled and/or finished edges and ends. Two colors of the Satin Series may be combined in the hexagon, stripe, and diagonal patterns.
